THE UKRAINIAN NATIONAL EMBLEM

One of Ukraine's national coat of arms is the TRIDENT which is the most ancient as well as the most dignified of all the Ukrainian insignia. Archaeological finds of tridents in Ukraine go back to the first century A.D.. This emblem signifies a mark of authority and a dynastic symbol that has been adopted by the Ukrainian people. The trident in its basic form is still used in Ukrainian folklore as a symbolic and religious emblem.
