A Statement of Purpose

Our world today is boiling in a struggle. We are vainly and furiously expanding our forces in a futile attempt at a sort of impossible reconciliation of two mutually contradictory life conceptions. Russian totalitarian Stalinism is stalking the earth, seeking its goal of world domination through aggression and terror. Opposed to it are the forces of Western Democracy struggling, blindly perhaps at times, for universal peace, brotherhood and freedom. Between the two there can be no compromise. Our attempt at reconciliation can end only in our destruction.

As with a collision of fire and water this vainly attempted compromise has bred a steamy atmosphere of irresolution so treacherous in its consequences, yet so desired. Desired by our foes in order that they may utilize its foggy ar of appeasement and indecision to further their ultimate goal, the enslavement of mankind. Foolishly desired by us so that we may buy time to hide from the grim realities of our existence; so that we may continue undisturbed in our lethargic indecision for a time, no matter how brief or disastrous it may be. It shall be the purpose of this Information Bulletin to contribute in clarifying the atmosphere, to show the issues of this great conflict as they are and not as we would like them to be, to determine who are our friends and who our enemies in the struggle and to suggest a course of action that will lead us out of our blindness.

To begin with, the usual description of the two opposing life conceptions as "East" and "West" is quite erroneous. The apparent simplicity of geographic distinction is leading us into the fatal fallacy of assuming that whatever is "West" is good and that whatever is "East" is, of necessity, evil. The truth is that in both "East" and "West" the diabolic forces of Russian Bolshevism are at work just as in both the forces of freedom and

EXTRADITION DEMANDED BY RUSSIANS

The reply of Benjamin Cohen, second Deputy Secretary General of the United Nations, on the ABN memorandum (which we mention in this issue) was received by the President of the Central Committee of the ABN. This memorandum had been submitted to the U.N. Secretariat by all the ABN national Delegates.

Deputy Secretary General of the U.N. Andrew Cordier has also informed the Ukrainian Delegation of the ABN that its memorandum received by the U.N. Secretariat has been submitted to all members nations.

Both memoranda were probably the reason for an extensive discussion in both the Political and Social Commissions on Jan. 7th and 8th. Delegates of USSR and so called satellites rigorously attacked among other, the Ukrainian Liberation Movement. The most venemous verbal assaults were launched against Ukrainian leaders Stepan Bandera and Andrij Melnyk in which even the extradition of these leaders to the USSR was demanded. However the majority of Delegates were unmoved by the Russian assaults.

There is no doubt that the Ukrainian Liberation Movement causes considerable trouble to the Soviet Russian rulers. Certainly it would give them pleasure to be able to "convince" their "stubborn brothers" from the Ukraine of the "happiness" in the Russian made "worker paradise", by the customary means of Soviet "dialectic" and special Russian "technique", such as gun shot in the neck. Fortunately the Western World is now aware of these tactics and refuses to return people to deliberate death.

7ake The Initiative Or Else

It is axiomatic in any conflict that. in order to win you must seize the initiative. A purely defensive effort against an aggressive force is inadequate to eventual victory. Thus far in the struggle between the Western Democracies and Bolshevist Russian Imperialism the initiative has always been on the side of the Kremlin. In the cold war it has been the Communists that have been on the offensive. In defense of Western Civilization the Democracies of the world have adopted a policy of vacillating confusion. Any unity and organization in their efforts has been subverted by futile attempts at appeasement, by disunity and by a timid reluctance to face up to the hard realities imposed by the struggle. Such a defense is of necessity inadequate. Such a policy is doomed to failure and its adherents to ultimate destruction if they continue in their errone ous beliefs.

It has been truly said that the best defense is a good offense. Any offensive action against the forces of Communist Imperialism must necessarily aim at the eventual overthrow of the present regime in U.S.S.R. If Western Democracy is to survive the warlords of the Kremlin must be destroyed.

ABN IDEAS AND AMERICA

Géza Erényi, Chairman of the Executive Council AFABN

Gentlemen: I wish to extend my heartfelt greetings to the Representatives of the various national origins members of sections of the American Friends of ABN Inc.

It is an exceptional pleasure to me to see the increased number of the national groups in our ranks after our modest start. I take the opportunity to call those who accept our idea and who have not joined us yet to come into our camp and not to go on in their individual ways, because we can only reach our goal with united strength. In any other case we would only waste our efforts and thus unwillingly promote the cause of our common enemy, the Kremlin.

The program of the present meeting is to give a report of our past activities and to draw the outlines of our plans for the coming year. And this will be the task of our esteemed secretary general. His report will be followed by a discussion.

And now allow me, gentlemen, to give you a short expose of the present world situation, emphasizing in this world picture the role of the U.S., the present situation of the AFABN in the U.S., and the out-looks and possibilities of this organization in the coming time.

You can sum up the world set-up in a few short pregnant words. There are two camps facing each other. The Kremlin, the throne of the Spirit of Negation which intends to destroy all that was proved good by the past generations, and the Western World with the U.S. as the spearhead, which is to save the world and mankind.

To this tremendous life and death struggle a third world power, a most genuine ally of the U.S. and the Western World is now arising. This is the A.B.N./ Antibolshevist Block of Nations /, representing the longing for freedom and independence of 24 nations, counting 200 million souls, oppressed by the Muscovite imperialism country and Viewling.

imperialism, now the red Kremlin.

We, the AFABN want to propagate the ideas of this third world power here in the U.S. We want the leaders and people of America to realize this fact, that Muscovite imperialism never could be beaten without this third world power, the ABN, and just to mention that this alliance would save a lot of sacrifices in blood and material for the Western World and the U.S., and it would shorten the period of the III. World War which is unavoidable according to our opinion.

The propagation of any great, although obviously simple idea that may alter the world's structure is always extremely difficult at the beginning. The ABN's propagation of its established ideas also had the same starting difficulties.

The ABN, which operates and has its headquarters in Europe, has there already overcome these beginning difficulties a long time ago. The administrations of the Western-European states are beginning to recognize the importance and the gigantic possibilities of the ABN's ideas.

Unfortunately this is not the case here in America. Here we are still facing the situation that they are fighting the Kremlin with a "Voice of America" full of fellow-travelers, and a Radio "Free Europe", packed with former communist collaborators. They endorse that Kerensky, who passed the power into Lenin's hand in 1917, and who is working now on substituting a "bolshevist Kremlin," with a "liberal Kremlin," of course in such a way, that it would remain the mighty central of an "Indivisible and Holy Mother Russia."

Here it can still happen that a man named Mr. Fred Forrest could accuse without any ground the whole leadership of the ABN with nazism, without the risk of responsibility, and talk mockingly of the great old man of the Scots, Mr. Stewart, the approved friend of the subjugated nations, and the fervent and convinced propagator of ABN's ideas.

The sole bright color in this dark and sad picture was the impressing article of the world-known English military author General Fuller, in the Oct. 27th issue of the "Saturday Evening Post," entitled: "What the Kremlin fears most." In this among others - Gen. Fuller wrote:

"Though a sufficiency of force is the first half of the solution, the amount needed will depend as much on the moral state of the Russian peoples as on the strength of the Russian army. The lower the first is, the weaker will the second be, and the weaker it is, the less will be the physical force required to vanquish it. The second half of the solution centers in the unbearable, Bolshevikrule, which has established a readymade second front in every country behind the Iron Curtain. Wherever Bolshevism is sown, anti-Bolshevism can be reaped. For, though by terror a people can be compelled to obey their masters, they cannot be compelled to cease hating them. Hatred is the Uranium 235 of the second half, and without it its physical prototype remains purely a weapon of material destruction. And of all explosives, psychological fission is the one the Kremlin dreads most, because it blows the bottom out of its ideology. Therefore to turn the U.S.S.R. into a gigantic psychological bomb is the second half of the solu-

Gen. Fuller, after making it clear that ABN is this dreadful psychological bomb,

comes to the following proposition:

"Because from past history there is no reason to suppose that a change of regime in Moscow will call a halt to the age-old urge of Russian expansion, the aim of the Western powers should coincide with the aim of the A.B.N. This means that the Soviet Empire must be dealt with as was

the Turkish - that is, split up into its component parts, each part becoming an independent country."

The same bright color could be seen in the November, 1951 issue of the "ABN Correspondence" in which Mr. John F. Stewart, the chairman of the "Scottish League for European Freedom" refuted point by point the accusations of Mr. Forrest, in the "New Leader" magazine, entitled: "Intolerance Incorporated."

Mr. Stewart in his magnificent article defending cause of ABN, wrote - among others - the following:

"I fully support the aims of ABN in opposing, not just communism, a name only adopted by Stalin to delude the West, not Stalinism, but the centuries-old world enemy, Russian Imperialism, and it makes no difference if this is run by Tsar, Bolshevik, Communist, Kerenskyist or any other. It is Russian Imperialism from which these nations have suffered for centuries, and the Russian people, like all other people, must bear the responsibility for their rulers' actions. They are different from the Russians, none has ever accepted Russian domination, they were brought into the Russian Empire by force and fraud, and to term them 'Separatists' is only silly and ignorant. They are nations."

Here in America, we, the members of AFABN are spokesmen for these oppressed. nations mentioned by Mr. Stewart, and when doing this, first of all, we are defending the interests of America, because we are convinced, that: it is the magnificent task of the U.S. to recognize the immense reserves of strength latent in the aspirations of the oppressed peoples, and utilize this strength, which can only exert itself to the fullest if America acknowledges the right of these peoples to the same freedom and independence which have made it the greatest and most prosperous of nations. Should this task be not fulfilled, should America and the Western world be indifferent again today as they were yesterday, tomorrow this barbarous Russian practice will involve the rest of the still free world and drive it to complete destruction.

EFFORTS TO PRESERVE U.S.S.R.'

In recent months, articles dealing with the solution of the national problems of nations in the U.S.S.R. have not disappeared from the pages of the Russian emigre newspapers. It is proper to remark that if the Russian emigres had denied these same basic and intense questions earlier and claimed that they were products of foreign intrigue or, still worse, the profit-seeking effort of a handful of people trying to secure ministerial portfolios, then now, on the eve of a forthcoming world catastrophe, witnessing the real danger of the dismemberment of the U.S.S.R. Russian empire they forget any possible fear of the consequences. Instead they instigated wild attacks, full of malicious lies and provocations against the national move-Instead they instigated ments of the Bolshevik enslaved nations and the leaders responsible for these Russian imperialists are movements. preoccupied with one thought; how to preserve the integrity of the Russian empire in any form. With this in mind, before the eyes of the free world they defame the noble-minded attempt of the Kremlin subjugated nations for freedom and rebirth of their sovereign states.

Simultaneously with this planned defamation the Russian emigres try with all their power to hide from the world the presence of national liberation movements behind the Iron Curtain or, failing this, to misrepresent their struggle as a fight only against the Bolshevist regime and not for their freedom and independence from any Russian control whatever. They would concede to the non-Russian peoples of the Russian Empire certain "rights" within the framework of a future Russia. By this they hope to delude world opinion into believing that a Russian State of the future, (as they envision it) would be a "voluntary federation" of these nations with Russia proper. Let us look at some of these claims and see whether all these pious declarations would not result in a continuance of Russian despotism.

They have consistently and heatedly repulsed any suggestion that the non-Russian peoples be allowed to choose for themselves, freely and without threat of recrimination, to determine their own national destinies.

In an effort to mask this brutal doctrine from the eyes of the free world they have created a so-called "Council of Liberation of the Peoples of Russia." The name has a strongly democratic ring to it. That was what was most desired.

However in the frenzied meetings of that august body one principle, and one principle alone was agreed upon unanimously, that Russia must be preserved as an indivisible union. They carefully erase all the history following 1917 which is a record of the growth of a constant demand for national self-expression on the part of the non-Russian populations of the Empire.

They have not been so politically naive as to show their true face in this, however. Instead they have adopted a logic-chopping self-contradictory statement of purpose. Their formula is this: "Acknowledge equal rights to all nations of Russia. Acknowledge their right to decide independently their future destiny and give practical assurances of this right." This part sounds wonderful. But here is the kicker. "The Council of Liberation of the Peoples of Russia considers as its fundamental task the preservation of the integrity of the family of nations of Russia.'

It is historically obvious that the non-Russian members of the 'family of nations of Russia" have consistently fought to get out of the family. They have fought for their inalienable right of national selfdetermination. They want no part of the "family." Indeed their membership in that "family" originated and is continued only by a policy of armed coersion.

Furthermore, they grant these rights only to nations now represented as Republics in the U.S.S.R. and ignore all the other national movements bumped together

in arbitrarily decided Soviet Republics.

They call for a plebiscite of all these republics after the overthrow of the present regime. Under the artificially imposed

ethnography such a plebiscite cannot help being a farce and the proponents of this planfully recognize this for they summarily exclude beforehand all the millions of victims of forced evacuation who were constrained to leave their native territory at the point of Russian guns. They freely include, of course, all the Russians living in non-Russian territory in their plebiscite to decide the future of the non-Russian nations. These Russians came in order to strengthen the iron grip of Bolshevik rule on the throats of the subjugated peoples. They came with violence and terror to dominate the non-Russian peoples and, according to this plan, their domina-tion will be allowed to continue this time by "democratic processes."

Typical of this program is their treat-

ment of the Cossack peoples. S.P. Melgu-now in the periodical "Rebirth" advises his Russian compatriots to acknowledge the rights of the Cossack people, to a federation in spite of the fact that he does not believe that they are a nation and have this right. In order to insure a complete subversion of any possible true expression of the Cossack people's rights to inde-pendence he stipulates "a necessary resistence to the propaganda of the Cos-sackian Independents." Melgunow and Melgunow and his cohorts see that the Cossack masses as well as Ukrainians for instance, will not be duped with the "One and Indivisible Russia" line. They are attempting to Russia" line. They are attempting to sabotage the efforts of the vast Cossackian masses for a rebirth of their country

The new "saviours of Russia" declare that they are fighting Stalin, but at the same time they endorse and employ the Stalinist political tactics concerning the national problem. In evidence of their "righteousness" they cite the proclamation of Malenkow pronounced at the 32nd anniversary of the Soviet regime that: "the former discord between nationalities changed in our country into a friendship and brotherhood of all nations." To confirm the words of the Malenkow's lie they introduce the words of the new Soviet anthem "the unimpeachable union of free nations forever forged together (with chains! -G.L.J.), the great Russia." They would preserve the bonds of the enslaved peoples of Russia.

To these chauvinists and imperialists who do not question all the horrors of Soviet slavery, all this is a "good Bolshevik service." They rejoice that Bolshevism "served this service to the Russian Empire." They do not seem to know the terrible price of blood and tears sorrow. the terrible price of blood and tears, sorrow and hardship, wild terror and violence, by which this 'good service' of the Bolshevik

regime was achieved. Moreover, Malgunow, one of the insti-gators of Kerensky's Council' not only recommends the preservation of the multinational Russian empire but even advocates the proposition "not to break or destroy the Soviet structure altogether "until a legislative meeting is called at Moscow, upon which a strongly centralized power is bestowed. Then the plebiscite will be conducted." To this he cynically adds, "without the forced cruelty of governmental pressure of the Bolshevik type" a federation of free nations cannot exist on the territory of Russia. In other words, all that these new "Sovietmen" have in store for our enslaved nations is a new cabala and new violences. All this only urges us to more efforts to join together our Cossack nation in a common front with all the rest of the nations represented in the Antibolshevist Block of Nations (ABN) to fight for a free Cossackia.

The American Friends of ABN are following this appeal by uniting Americans of various national origins in order to help the fighting ABN and to contribute in gaining freedom for the peoples of Central and Eastern Europe as well as of a large part of Asia now subjugated by Russia. They are following this appeal of the ABN because they firmly believe that the only way to real world peace lies in vanquishing Russian imperialism under the guise of Bolshevism. Annexed by Russia and for centuries oppressed, non-Russian countries have to be returned to their rightful owners and free, independent and democratic national states have to be reestablished.

The American Friends of ABN realize - and wish to help every American to understand the fact that there exist many non-Russian peoples behind the Iron Curtain and not one Russian people - as Russian "democrats" (imperialists) and their American co-workers would want the world to believe. It is also of the utmost importance that the USA and the world at large understand that these non-Russian peoples have their own culture, history, language and way of life, often far more advanced than the Russians themselves: Byelorussians, Ukrainians, Cossacks, Idel-Uralians, Georgians, Caucasus peoples, Azerbaydjanians, Turkestanians - are the separate nations and as such deserve their national independence as well as the Baltic peoples (Estonians, Latvians, Lithuanians), the people of Central Europe or the Balkans (Poles, Hungarians, Czechs, Slovaks, Rumanians, Bulgarians, Croatians, Serbians, Slovenians, Albanians). All are entitled to be saved from being completely "engulfed and digested" by Russian imperialism.

The ABN by its vast struggle against Bolshevism is tearing down this mask of Russian imperialism. Thousands and hundreds of thousands of the ABN guerillas and underground fighters are sacrifying their lives in this struggle. These fighters express the unshakable will of their peoples to liberate themselves from the imperialistic yoke. They are dying not for Russia but for their own national countries in achieving independence and freedom.

The American Friends of ABN are of the opinion that it is the sacred duty of the Western world under the guidance of the USA to bring effective help to those ABN fighters if we want to win this world struggle for freedom, which could not be won without the help of ABN peoples. This help must come soon.

Taking the ABN slogans for their own, the American Friends of ABN appeal to Americans and to the whole Western world: UNITE IN THE STRUGGLE AGAINST BOLSHEVISM - AND ANY FORM OF RUSSIAN IMPERIALISM!

democracy are in operation. Indeed, in spite of their striking minority on both sides of the Iron Curtain, the advocates of Russian totalitarianism have used our failure to recognise and act upon this reality as one of their principal sources of strength. By constructing an Iron Curtain between East and West, by systematically russifying or exterminating the allies of the West in the Russian subjugated and "satellite" nations, by separating and misrepresenting the advocates of democracy one to another, by ruthlessly destroying all opposition to its tyranny within its borders, the Bolshevist menace has thus far succeeded in dividing, confusing and weakening its opponents.

SECRETS OF STRENGTH AND WEAKNESS

The secret of the strength of the Bolshevist forces lies in the unity of their corrupt beliefs among its followers in both East and West. The tragic weakness in the Democratic forces is the disunity in the West and the mutual lack of understanding between the forces of freedom of West and East. That Russian deceit, corruption and aggression are the prime movens of this weakness is underiable.

Nevertheless, we in the West are not altogether blameless in our weakness. Our congenital ability for procrastination, our weak-kneed avoidance of trouble, our acceptance of Russian lies have all led us to our present state of indecision and irresolution. In our pathological terror at causing any sort of disturbance in the world we have allowed millions of potential allies to exist in misery, enslavement and oppression where they are permitted to exist at all. So terrible has been our neglect that we are now threatened with the same fate to which we have abandoned our allies.

By failing to recognize, either through ignorance or deliberate choice, the vast resources of strength for Democracy existing in the subjugated nations of the Soviet Union, the West has woefully weakened itself. By fatuously accepting the Russian lie that the Soviet Union is a union, by refusing aid to the peoples struggling to escape from the Russian "guardianship" the West is allowing itself to drop deeper and deeper into the mire of spiritual and moral irresolution.

RUSSIAN IMPERIALISM IN BUSINESS

Russian imperialism recognizes the weakness that we ignore. Its history is the history of an attempt to eradicate all that is not Russian within its borders. By deliberate and systematic starvation, deportation, by typically Russian "processes," kidnapping and murder Bolshevism has ruthlessly attempted to extirpate all non-Russian religion, culture and national sentiment from within the Soviet borders. Russian aggression has tried to make its victims forget that they are not Russian and to eliminate all who refuse to forget. That it has thus far failed is no credit to us, for we have cooperated in this genocide by our refusal to oppose it.

Thus far we have failed to recognize, either through ignorance or choice, the full extent of the traditional savagery of Russian Bolshevism. Russian foreign ministers are allowed to laugh their sarcastic and professionally cynical laughs at Western peace proposals while thousands of defenseless U.N. prisoners of war have been ruthlessly murdered by Russian "satellites."

The Western powers beg for peace with the murderers and react to that insulting laughter by appeals for 'seriousness.' They are quite content and do not take notice when the Russians, tired of laughing, become more

serious... in new murders.
Russian imperialism has thus far been successful in its attempts to keep the West off balance and disunited by organizing and maintaining vast networks of agents and propagandists inside the Western democra-

RUSSIAN 5th and 6th COLUMNS

The espionage of the traditional fifth column of the Harry Gold-Claus Fuchs and Red Front organizations are well known. The equally dangerous and more insidious "Sixth" column of Russian imperialism is not. Composed of so-called "White" Russians and "Anti-Communist" supporters of indivisible Russia, organizations spread confusion and falsehood concerning the truth of the opposition to Russian imperialism behind the Iron Curtain. Looking back with wistful eyes to the days of Russian aggression under Ivan, Peter and Catherine, they would have us believe that there is unity within Russia, that there is no opposition to Russian Imperialism in its twentieth century Bolshevist form, that the "Russian People" are united in opposition to Stalin and that those who oppose the russification and suppression of separate national cultures are wild-eyed fanatics belonging to a lunatic fascist fringe that constitutes no real source of strength to the West. They would have the Democracies approve and endorse the Russian aggression under the Tsars and guarantee its survival in a future "non-communist" Russia. They would have us believe that the Russians oppose Stalin when, in reality, Stalin's strength derives from their support of his imperialistic expansion and oppression of the non-Russian nationalities in the Soviet Union.

TREAT OF WESTERN FAILURE

Unable to establish an underground network of their own behind the Iron Curtain and persuaded by the Russian sixth column that no national liberation movements of non-Russian peoples exist behind the Iron Curtain, the West has been unable to exploit the basic weakness in the Russian Empire. Ignoring these non-Russian national liberation movements and the underground armies that have fought Russian aggression since its inception and are still fighting it, we dispatch thousands of balloons to the satellite countries, affirming our faith in the traditional good fellowship of the Russian people, and urge resistance to Communism, all the while automatically guaranteeing Russians' hope of the continuation of their imperialism.

LIGHT IN DARKNESS

Happily, however, the picture is not all gloom. There are hopeful signs of a change in Western policy. It is the purpose of this bulletin and our organization, the American Friends of the Anti-Bolshevist Block of Nations, to contribute all our efforts to this change so that one day we may see peoples and the world free from the slavery of Russian imperialism.

EFFORTS NEEDED

To do this requires much effort. First of all the West must free itself from the delusion that it is possible to live in peace with the forces of Russian imperialism. The threat to the freedom of one nation is a threat to the freedom of all. The foggy atmosphere of appeasement must be dispelled. Facts must be seen as they are.

Then, we must oppose the corrupt alliance of Bolshevistforces in East and West with a stronger unity of people dedicated to the fight for the freedom of nations and the freedom of individuals. Bolshevist aggression must be met with firmer counter-action. Evil force must be opposed with a force for Good. The fires of hate must be quenched in a fire of love. We must crush Russian imperialism not from hatred of Russians but from a deeper love of freedom and peace for all nations subjugated by them and for the Russian people itself.

COMMON FRONT OF ACTION

Finally and most important: an anti-Bolshevist front must be organized. We must utilize all the anti-Bolshevist forces already existing on both sides of the Iron Curtain. The major portion of the population of the so-called Soviet Union who are not only non-Russian but also anti-Russian are ready to join the rest of the freedom loving peoples of the world. Thus far we have ignored them. We can afford to

ignore them no longer. The Anti-Bolshevist Block of Nations (ABN) our logical partner in the struggle against Russian Bolshevism, must be accepted as such. Not to do so would be disastrously silly.

Our common front must not be one of sentiment alone. It must be a common front of action. The peoples of ABN can do without affection of sentiments. They need affection of action. For the ABN is a union of action.

THE ABN - THE ONLY PARTNER

At the present time the ABN is the only force taking direct action in opposition to Russian Bolshevist aggression inside the Iron Curtain. fighters are already in the field and have been for a long time while we have been idly seeking for a false security. In the national liberation movements of the various non-Russian peoples enslaved in the Soviet Russian Empire can be found a vast reservoir of material and psychological strength that up till now we have ignored. To defeat Communist-Russian Imperialism without the active support of this underground would be disastrously expensive if not impossible. We must unite with them or fail.

This then is our purpose. We exist to convince the American people and its leaders of the supreme necessity of a partnership with the forces which are already fighting Red Imperialism within the Iron Curtain. Our aim is to contribute in uniting the forces opposed to Bolshevist aggression in a

common front of action.

We shall attempt to clear out much of the fog that has obscured the actions of the Western Democracies. We shall attempt to tear away the many masks that hide the naked Soviet aims. Russian aggression must be seen in its true light as a violent, ruthless enemy which is never so dangerous as when operating in the guise of friendship, peace and benificence. We shall meet the moral challenge of Communism, as well as of Russian imperialism hidden behind a guise of democratic phrases. Our concern, in the words of Lincoln, shall not be to get God on our side but rather to get on God's side, and with HIS help we shall succeed in our purpose in bringing freedom to nations and freedom to individuals.

"Our forefathers have given us the basis of a real foreign policy worthy of our heritage if we have the courage to use it. It is not based on fear or appeasement... The Declaration of Independence can be the basis of a foreign policy of liberation.

We have to raise our voice not only against the ignorance and malicious accusations, but against such benevolent errors like that appeared in the editorial of the Daily News, otherwise an excellent, popular newspaper, Dec. 23, 1951:

The Daily News commenting on the recent trip of a London banker, Mr. Eric Smith, to Russia, wrote at the end of its

editorial:

"He would like to see all trade - not just trade in military goods - cut off between the Iron Curtain countries and the West. Russia, he says, 'depends..for its life on the Capitalist West and..to render it harmless we need only freeze the cold war solid, and isolate Russia." Give the Soviets that kind of treatment for 20 years or so, and Smith thinks Russia will fall so far behind us that it won't be able to fight any kind of war. In the process of falling behind, he believes it more than likely that the Soviet tyranny itself will wither away - after which a new deal between the West and the Curtain countries, based on common sense and realities, should be possible.." So the Daily News. To cut off instantly every kind of trade with the Soviet Union, would be all right. But to freeze in and let that 200 million souls, overtaken by the Kremlin as a result of the shortsightedness of the Western World, to their fate, would not only mean the destruction of those people struggling in slavery, but that of the Western World and finally that of America, which disregarding the threatening dangers from the part of the Vth column, would also be stewed in its own juice, since even now she is hardly finding a real market for her industrial products.

Fortunately a good part of the American people, and America officially do not share

the opinion of Mr. Eric Smith.

Consequently we have the good right to hope that Mr. Stewart's prophecy - given in his answer to Mr. Forrest - will come true:

"On the other hand, America is at least groping for a policy after a period of complete ignorance, and it is American public opinion and its increasing pressure that is carrying the day, will disintegrate any Russian Empire, put these ancient nations again on their feet, confine the Russians to their own ethnic territory; where they will have to begin to make an honest living."

In their efforts to prepare for the overthrow of the Stalinist regime in Russia, strategists of the West have been hampered by two erroneous concepts, the effects of which nullify all of their efforts. The first is that the Russian people are opposed to Stalin. The second is that all the peoples living within the borders of the Soviet Union are Russians.

The fallacy of the first concept is now being revealed by students of the Russian people who show that present day Russian Imperialism is merely a logical outgrowth of the imperialism of the former Tsarist regime. As such it flatters the Russian national consciousness imbued with the ideal of "Mother Russia" and "Holy Moscow."

The falsity of the second concept is proven by the existence of guerilla armies representing the oppressed ethnic groups behind the Iron Curtain. These armies are already in the field, already fighting our battles for us. They stand as centers of resistance to the Soviet imposed unity behind the Iron Curtain and as germs of the eventual overthrow of the forces of Bolshevism.

Only when the West realizes the truth of the above propositions will any effective offensive action against the forces of international Bolshevism be possible. Having realized this the West under the leadership of the United States must do something about the existing situation.

A correct appraisal of the situation will reveal that the only effective action can be in the form of direct material support to the peoples in revolt against the present Soviet regime. This must have as its antecedant recognition of the existence of the suppressed nations behind the Iron Curtain by the diplomats of the West. After this step has been taken, the stage will then be set for direct military aid to the insurgent armies of these peoples.

When we realize that one division of guerillas is sufficient to divert from five to seven divisions of an enemy by their mere existence behind the enemies lines, we can get some small estimate of the military potential of the nations represented by the ABN.

Yet, we continue to recognize an international criminal conspiracy as the true government of 800 million suffering people."

BEHIND THE IRON CURTAIN

THE REAL RECORD OF RUSSIA - 12,713 PRISONS

There is one undeniable record of Russian technique and that is the building of prisons for political non-followers and fighters for national independence of the non-Russian peoples.

A former director of a Russian prison gave the following precise information on the subject. In the Ukraine alone at the end of 1949, there were 115 prisons, 24 concentration camps, 5 political prison camps and 145 forced labor camps. These are situated mainly in the industrial and mining districts and change their names from time to time.

The growth of prisons in the entire Soviet Union can be gauged from the fol-

lowing outline:

When we add 670 prisons in Poland, the 115 in Roumania, the 53 in Czechoslovakia, the 43 in Hungary, the 48 in Bulgaria and the 24 in Albania, we learn that in 1950 there were 12,713 prisons in Russian occupied territory. Is it not a real achievement? There is no doubt that no country can excel the Soviet Union in this record and that the U.S.S.R. shall beat itself Stachanow-like.

A SAMPLE OF A RUSSIAN CONDUCTED "PLEBISCITE"

The Soviet Russian newspaper 'Komsololskoja Pravda' No. 307 (678651) reports the results of the elections of deputies to the provincial, district-county and city soviets of the working people of the Uzbek Soviet Socialist Republic and the Azerbeydjan Soviet Socialist Republic. The results are illustrated by numbers, among which we meet these. The general number of the voters in the provisional Soviet in the Azerbeydjan SSR was 1,045,193. In the election 1,045,192 participated. In the city and village soviets there were 1,031,765 potential voters and 1,031,763 actually voted.

Thus, in the first instance only one person did not cast his ballot, in the second, two. Is this not a record of Russian plebiscite abilities? But this is no wonder because there were even occasions when the potential voters were outnumbered by the actual electors.

It is not necessary to add that all elected were the 'best' men of the districts. They were all passed on the governmental 'most democratic' list. Furthermore it is not necessary to add that all those who were elected were either Russians or willing servants of the Russians. Of this we have

THE UKRAINIAN PEASANTS RESIST

In the late summer and early fall of last year the rulers of Soviet Russia were waging a special campaign against the peasantry of the Western Ukraine. They were attempting the collectivisation of all West Ukrainian husbandry and soon met the stubborn resistence of a large part of the Ukrainian peasants. In their attempts to quell this resistance the Bolshevists have exported over 7,000 peasants during August and September of 1951. These

unfortunates were forcibly expelled from their homelands and shipped to other parts of the Ukraine or to Siberia.

The Ukrainian peasants were charged with sabotaging the Kolchoses and failing in the delivery of satisfactory amounts of grain to the state. The persecution was especially strong in areas where the Greek Catholic Church still retains some influence. The Soviet press is noising it about that a spirit of "bourgeois nationalism" is growing in the Western Ukraine. The NKVD men, party speakers and communist propagandists loudly protest that this so-called sabotage is organized by the West in the person of American agents. They would have their world believe that the Ukrainian independence movement and the fight of the Ukrainian peasants for life and freedom was organized and sponsored by America. They charge that Truman, "the greatest fascist," seeks in this way to rule the Ukraine. They claim that they have been the 'only friends of the Ukrainian people' and that they are the 'only ones who would take care' of them.

It is curious to note how many people have had pretensions of taking care of the Ukrainians. First the Tsarist Russians, then the Communist Russians and Polish imperialists, next the Hitlerite Germans, now the Kerensky's Russians, have such "care" in mind. It would seem to us that the only people who would truly care for the Ukrainians are the Ukrainian people themselves.

STALIN - "NEW GOD" FOR HUNGARY

The Central Committee of the Communist Party in Hungary sent a kind of circular to all hospitals in Budapest last fall. This circular "suggests" that a portrait of Stalin is to be exhibited in all halls, waiting rooms and patients' rooms. First of all Stalin's portrait must hang in all operating rooms so that the patient can look directly into Stalin's eyes. The patient must realize that Stalin is watching and that he is taking care of his health.

Thus the Hungarian people acquired a new god. It is not the One Who was professed by Cardinal Mindszenty, but rather the one whose worship is enforced by the Russian NKVD or its Hungarian servants.

It is known that the Russian artist Postnikow painted a portrait of Stalin entitled "J.W. Stalin, Creator of Human Happiness." Certainly this "Creator" should be watching over all Hungarians from the small child in kindergarten to his last minutes in life. If you consider this preposterous, then listen to the Soviet Russian house radio and it could happen that you will hear something like what was heard on January 21, 1952:

A small boy actor is standing with a group, late at night underneath Stalin's lighted window and imagines his 'Creator' to be still working. (We translate) 'And then, I suppose, the light goes out and heactually goes to sleep. Well do you know I simply can't realize him going to sleep like other people. But it's just that I can't realize it, somehow. Not him. And do you know, whenever the sun rises over Moscow I always think it's he, Stalin, who switches on the light . '' Isn't that something?

Ukrainian Patriots—"The Most Dangerous Enemies of the Ukrainian People"

(UIS) At the recent meeting of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of the Ukraine held in Kiev, Moscow's gauleiter Melnikov delivered a report concerning "the condition of the ideological work and moves towards its improvement." After the report the meeting adopted a series of resolutions, fragments of which were published by "Radianska Ukrajina" in December 1951. Among other things these resolutions state 'the Ukrainian bourgeoisie and its nationalist ideologists have always been the vilest agency of foreign imperialism and have always been the most dangerous enemies of the Ukrainian people. They have strived to rip the Ukrainian people from its nearest ally and older brother, the Russian people; they have strived to rip the Ukrainian culture apart from the fraternal Russian culture. In particular, the Ukrainian nationalists have rigorously and fiercely opposed the highest expression of Russian culture, Leninism." Finally a continuous and relentless fight against any indication of Ukrainian struggle for independence is pledged.

TRUMAN'S AND CONGRESS MESSAGE MISINTERPRETED

UNINTENDED REACTIONS

It is always interesting for the Americans to know the state of mind of the peoples living behind the Iron Curtain and to be informed of their reactions to the moves of the Western Democracies.

Of particular interest is the reaction to the declaration of friendship made by the Senate of the U.S. to the Russian people and the letter sent by President Truman to the president of the U.S. St. (Shvernik), showing that our good will and honest sincerity is not enough to fight the wild Soviet Russian aggressive bestiality.

In this connection we are authorized to publish the findings made by the Cossackian Department of Defense (OKO) of the Cossackian underground movement through its division operating behind the Iron Curtain. The report was received shortly before we went to press.

The reaction to the overtures of friend-

ship was twofold.

The ruling class, the Communist Party members and the Russians themselves were extremely heartened by both messages. They viewed them enthusiastically as signs of weakness and timidity on the part of the American People and their leaders. Shortly after the publication of these documents huge public meetings were arranged throughout the whole Soviet territory, particularly in the subjugated areas. The rallying cry at these mass demonstrations was "Let's Get America" (Dayosh Ameriku!). At these meetings the party members were under orders to convince the people of the strength of mother Russia and their great God Stalin and to show how the rest of the world was bowing down in fear before them. They did not even hide their intention to scare the non-Russian people.

On the other hand, the non-Russian peoples, who are living in the hope that the Western World and America in particular will come to their aid in their efforts for national liberation from the Russian yoke, were extremely disappointed. This resulted in some cooling off of the sympathies of the non-Russian peoples for

the Western Democracies.

'VOICE OF AMERICA' REPUDIATED

By same source (O.K.O.) we are informed that in a recent broadcast beamed to the areas of the North Caucasus, the Voice of America spoke through the mouth of one Mrs. S. K., the wife of a noted artist who is now living in the U.S. She described her and her husband's sufferings first under the Bolshevist regime and then under the German Nazis in their native Rostow on the Don.

IGNORANCE INCORPORATED

"The credit that is got by a lie only lasts till the truth is out"

While the Western World and its political leaders become more and more ac-quainted with the ideas of the Antibolshe-vist Block of Nations (ABN) and while this organization is increasing its strength in its struggle for the freedom of the peoples subjugated by Russia, there appear, here and there, even in our country, organs of the press, journalists and writers who seem extremely critical of our efforts. They seem to be of the opinion that these enslaved peoples and nations ought not to be free. They appear to be engaged in an outright sme ar campaign directed against these peoples' liberation movements and their leaders.

There are two general ideological categories into which these opponents of ABN fall. The members of the first look with nostalgia-dimmed eyes at the days of the Czars and, while anti-Communist, would nevertheless support a non-communist continuation of Russia in her historic role of imperialist and aggressor nation. They oppose only the present regime, not the principles of Russian Imperialism. The second of these two categories advocates nothing in particular and seems to be composed of an odd assortment of fuzzy-minded so-called "liberals" whose only appeal appears to be directed to those who delight in logic chopping, character assassination and a categorical denial of the ratiocinative processes of the human intellect. Their completely negative outlook on the problem is coupled with a sensitive predilection for loudmouthed rabble rousing. Articles of Fred Forrest, David J. Dallin, Robert Shaplen could serve as "shining" examples. Typical of the frenzied outbursts seems

to be an article written by a Fred Forrest in the September 10th issue of the "New Leader." Entitled "Intolerance Incorpo-Leader." Entitled "Intolerance Incorporated," it is part of a series called 'Allies We Don't Need' which purports to reveal the inner workings of anti-democratic

groups. Mr. Forrest, the author of this bit of phantasy, is described as a "Former U.S. Intelligence Agent and a veteran student of foreign affairs." We are not aware of precisely what qualifications one must possess to be termed by 'the New Leader' 'veteran student of foreign affairs," and the 'New Leader' makes no attempt to enlighten us but, from an intensive reading of the article, they seem to in-clude all the mental characteristics of a congenital malignancy. The appellation "U.S. Intelligence Agent," in this light, appears to be an exalted tribute to the military for its oft-quoted, uncanny ability to fit square pegs into round holes.

We feel sorry for the superiors of those who had such a type of "intelligence." On the other hand we feel sorrier for their eventual victims. We speak of the thousands of D.P.'s who, against their will, were forcibly "repatriated" to the Soviet Union in 1945 and 1946 as a result of the efforts of such "intelligence agents." We speak of those who committed suicide rather than face such a fate. The blood of those who thus ended their lives rather than face an enforced "repatriation" to the "workers' paradise" might be on the heads of intelligence agents and students of Soviet affairs as seem to conform to Mr. Forrest's type. We find it really fortunate that the latter can be considered as a ''former'' one only.

Two of the chief techniques of our second category of opponents are: first, that the organization under attack is antisemitic, second, that it is fascist. Mr. Forrest outdoes himself. He employs both devices and finds a sort of semantic unity by illustrating his piece of journal-istic derring-do with the portrait of one A. Rosenberg whose connection with the ABN, the organization under attack is never explained. We are doubtlessly supposed to recoil in horror at the mere mention of his name in any connection or, if no logical connection exists, make an emotional one. A subtitle tells us more.
"Former Nazi minions still in business," screams Mr. Forrest, "advocate the dis-memberment of Russia."

The first part of that statement is a direct lie, as we shall show. The second part is equally false. The ABN, and we, do not advocate the dismemberment of Russia but rather the dismemberment of the Province Empire V the Russian Empire. It is our contention that what is known today as Soviet Russia is an empire not a nation. It is our contention that the unity of Russia is one based upon the application of force from above. It is our contention that the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics is a forced union of Russian subjugated nations. The facts bear out our contentions and thus our position demands the restriction of Russia within Russian ethnic boundaries. There is no doubt that Mr. Forrest is absolutely free to love Russians and to hate the non-Russian peoples - as he obviously appears to do. We would not even mind when he declares himself a fighter for a new Russian Empire; we ought however expect from him to wage this fight with all means but lie and insinuations, what might be good for a Russian but never for an American. Having established this, let us now deal with Mr. Forrest's two specific false accusations.

The first libel, the charge of antisemitism, is patently false. However in our society, dedicated to principles of brotherhood and democracy such a charge, while easy to make, is hard to disprove in the face of an almost universal prejudice against prejudice or even the slightest appearance of prejudice. It all too often happens that a charge of prejudice is deliberately used as a cover-up or as a direct slander.

Happily in this case it is easily proven The testimony of Jews fighting side by side with their neighbor Ukrainians in the ABN supported Ukrainian Insurgent Army against Russian imperialism is alone sutticient. To this add the testimony of many other Jews who were saved from Nazi terror by this same Ukrainian Insur-

gent Army, the bulk of whose medical corps is composed of Jewish doctors. One alludes to Jewish pogroms in the Ukraine during World War I but forgets to mention that they were Russian inspired. He speaks of the antisemitism of the ABN but never alludes to the Russian slogan "Kill Jews - Save Russia" (By) Shydowspassaj Rosseju). He does not reter to the Russian 'cherta posselosty' (settlement border) inside of which no Jew was allowed to live, nor does he mention today's Russian antisemitism.

His remaining charge, that of Nazi affiliation is made equally ridiculous by the facts of history; the fact that in 1943, at the height of Nazi power in the Ukraine the Ukrainian underground army took the field against the Nazi horde, in spite of its already existing front against the hordes of Russian Bolshevists.

Mr. Forrest's calumnious treatment of Mr. Stetzko, President of the ABN, of John F. Stewart and of the Scottish League for European freedom, of Prof. Lew Dobriansky and others, is a masterpiece of vilification conforming to all the noble ideals of complete character as sassination. In them he demonstrates an uncanny imaginative ability for thinking up gross falsehoods combined with craftsmanship

in slinging mud.

At this, point let us trace the brief history of ABN. The organization was nistory of ABN. The organization was founded by representatives of thirteen Russian subjugated nations in 1943 at the height of the Nazi power. Mr. Forrest's charge that ABN was founded in 1946 by what he calls "Banderovite Ukrainians" is a direct fabrication. In its short history it has opposed both Nazi and Communist efforts to enslave the peoples it represents. Its soldiers have died fighting both aggressors and will continue fighting for their ideals which are identical with those of Democracy.

We wish we had more time and space to present a fuller exposure of Forrest's outright intellectual malignancy but our budget is far smaller than that of the "New Leader." There is a final absurdity in his logic that we feel compelled to

point out.

According to Mr. Forrest the ABN is not only antisemitic and Nazi but also infiltrated by Communists. This is indeed a revelation. We do admit that ABN would be a prime target for Communist infiltration but we know for a fact that such infiltration has been completely thwarted. However, Mr. Forrest, as always, ignores facts, plays upon popular sympathy and employs emotional invective rather than intelligent argumentation.

We would like to express our own sense of wonderment as to the possible causes for this vehement outburst of calumny. Was it for notoriety's sake? This couldn't be because the "New Leader" isn't of very wide circulation. Was it simply a perverse sadism in attack-ing what he thought could not defend itself? Was it for the sake of money? We do not know ... We wonder ...

In conclusion - the great danger, Mr. Forrest is writing about, concluding his article, really exists but not - as he would like to persuade the readers - of the ABN.
The ABN is fighting for freedom to Nations and Individual and as such is not dangerous to anybody but to Russian imperialism. A real great danger comes from the Russian imperialists and their ardent promoters - like Mr. Forrest, for instance, - who flurrying real situations, guizing and protecting real enemy, are undermining and weakening defense of this country and paving the road for Russian World domination.

MEMORANDUM OF ABN TO THE UNITED NATIONS

(rc) A memorandum sent to the United Nations by the Central Committee of the Anti-Bolshevist Bloc of Nations, on the occasion of their meeting in Paris, adequately summarizes the aims, purposes and ideals of the organization this bulletin supports.

supports.

The letter begins by outlining the basic cause of the present world crisis which can be found in the Bolshevist Russian policy of aggressive imperialism. This program of eventual world domination the Central Committee states, is a historical outgrowth of the imperialistic program of the now defunct Tsarist regime.

Not only has this policy resulted in the suppression and exploitation of non-Russian ethnic groups within the borders of the Soviet Union but also, united with the Bolshevist thesis of Marx and Lenin it constitutes an ever present threat to the existence of freedom and democracy anywhere in the world. The Communist threat to civilization is made more imminent by the existence of well organized Kremlin supported fifth column movements throughout the world.

Enumerating some of the countless instances of Russian barbarism and tyranny against the suppressed peoples contained in its 'dungeon of nations' the letter goes on to point out the folly of any attempt at appeasement or the reconciliation of two such opposing principles as Democracy and Totalitarianism.

The ABN Committee then proceeds to enumerate the many reasons why ABN, the representative of these enslaved peoples, stands in eternally undying opposition to this barbaric policy of tyranny and oppression. It shows how true world peace can never be attained while the authors of this policy are in control of Russia. The present regime in Moscow can be defeated only by a common front of all the freedom loving peoples of the world both outside and inside the Russian "dungeon of nations."

The Committee then enumerates a nine point program which would implement their aims and which they urge the U.N. to adopt. The program includes a plan for uniting all the forces opposed to the Bolshevist program of world domination and the destruction of the threat to world peace. In addition it calls for the breaking off of all diplomatic ties with the Soviet regime and the recognition of the spokesmen of the oppressed peoples by their admission to the U.N.

Finally the program calls for the recognition of the insurgent armies already in the field fighting communist imperialism and material support of the peoples in revolt.

It is extremely ironic to note that this "famous" couple were indeed well known in the area - as NKVD helpers and German collaborators, who "helped" to death many of their innocent neighbors.

It is a well known fact in the area that during a time when hundreds of thousands were perishing from hunger and persecution, this infamous couple arranged sumptuous orgies in their grand house where, together with official party and NKVD men, they plotted the pityless robbery of their neighbors. For these services they were awarded many decorations and distinctions by a grateful Soviet government.

With the German occupation of Rostow this "artistic couple" found new masters. They immediately shifted their allegiance to the Nazis and continued their work for their own and the Germans' profit.

From Rostow the couple moved to Germany and took jobs in the Goebbels Propaganda Abteilung.

The couple is now enjoying sanctuary in the United States, protected from any harm. The effect of their broadcasts to the people of their native country, who know them too well is hardly in the best interests of the United States. To say the least their audience is unreceptive and a bit disappointed.

We learn also from other sources, as Ukrainian for instance, that there are serious shortcomings to the whole Voice of America program.

CONFERENCE ON PSYCHOLOGICAL WARFARE IN WASHINGTON

On February 22nd and 23rd, a Conference on Psychological Strategy, sponsored by Congressmen O.K. Armstrong and Ch.J. Kersten, took place in Washington. Profound and thoughtful addresses were read by distinguished personalities. Representatives of many national groups were present. The conference was also attended by representatives of American Friends of ABN, Inc., delegations from New York and Chicago. Chairman of the Executive Council, Mr. Erényi Géza, addressed the Conference stating the position of this organization on the present world situation and on the necessity to help the peoples behind the Iron Curtain in their fight against Russian imperialism.

As a result of the conference, resolutions were passed which, in general, are in keeping with the objects and ideals of the American Friends of ABN. Among other things, the establishment of a 'Central Psychological Strategic Agency' was urged.

Although tendencies on the part of Russian imperialists to dominate the course of the Conference were tactfully suppressed by the sponsors of the Conference, who showed their full understanding and sympathy for the struggle of the peoples behind the iron curtain in their fight for liberation and national independence, the American Friends of ABN prefer to take a reserved attitude until such time that words will be turned into action. It goes without saying that any action serving the cause of liberating the peoples subjugated by Russia will always have the fullest cooperation of the American Friends of ABN.
