Ukrainian Canadian Art Foundation

A special Canada Post cancel and cacheted-illustrated cover commemorating the 20th anniversary of the Ukrainian Canadian Art Foundation have been prepared to be used on Saturday, October 7, 1995.

The Ukrainian Canadian Art Foundation (UCAF) is one of the best known Ukrainian cultural centers in Toronto. It was founded in 1975 by Mr. and Mrs. Szafraniuk.

Over the past 20 years, a large number of gatherings, literary evenings and lectures have taken place at the UCAF. In addition, the UCAF has been host to over 350 art exhibits. In 1982, the UCAF hosted an international exhibit which featured the works of 88 Ukrainian artists from 9 countries.

The works of such prominent artists as J. Hnizdovsky, E. Kozak, M. Levytsky, O. Archipenko and P. Lopata have been featured. In recent years, well known artists from Ukraine have exhibited at the UCAF.

The UCAF art collection numbers approximately 800 works and is continuously enriched with new additions to the collection.

Ukrainian Philatelist

A special Canada Post cancel and cacheted-illustrated cover commemorating the 70th anniversary of the journal, Ukrainian Philatelist, have been prepared to be used on Sunday, October, 8, 1995.

Ukrainian Philatelist was first published in Vienna in 1925. Edited by Dr. I. Turyn, Ukrainian Philatelist quickly gained recognition as the authoritative journal of Ukrainian philately. Contributors to the journal included such renowned philatelists as E. Wyrowyj, S. Shramchenko and M. Sekretar among many others. In addition to familiarizing philatelists worldwide with aspects of Ukrainian philately, the journal also contributed to the development of Ukrainian philatelic terminology. Ukrainian Philatelist was often recognized and awarded medals at international philatelic exhibits. Publication of the journal ended in 1939 with the outbreak of World War II.

In 1971, the official journal of the Ukrainian Philatelic and Numismatic Society was renamed, Ukrainian Philatelist. Ukrainian Philatelist continues the tradition of excellence in philatelic publication established 70 years ago capturing many awards at philatelic expositions.

UKRAINIAN PHILATELIC AND NUMISMATIC SOCIETY (UPNS)

An international society devoted to the promotion of Ukrainian philately and numismatics was founded by Dr. I. Turyn in Vienna in 1925. The society published the journal, *Ukrainskyi Filatelist*, before it was disbanded in 1939. Mr. K. Lissiuk, owner of the Lissiuk Philatelic Co. of New York City, was the principal benefactor and financial supporter of the journal.

In 1950, a group of Ukrainian collectors in New York City created an initiative committee to form a society of Ukrainian philatelists. In 1951, the Society of Ukrainian Philatelists was officially established. Dr. Eugene Kotyk was elected president, Peter Vojnovsky vice-president, Jaroslav Petesh secretary, and Stepan Kikta treasurer.

In June 1951, the first issue of a journal, *Philatelist*, was published by an editorial board. As the society grew, Dr. Kotyk became the first editor of the journal, and in 1953, an English language column was introduced. During the late 1950s and the 1960s, the society struggled financially and the journal was published sporadically.

In 1971, the society was reorganized under a new president, Dr. G. Slusarczuk. The journal was now published annually in the English and Ukrainian languages and was renamed *Ukrainian Philatelist*. A system of public auctions was introduced and managed by Mr. V. Zabijaka.

In 1972, the society changed its name to the Ukrainian Philatelic and Numismatic Society and a newsletter, *Visnyk*, was added to the society's publications.

From 1976 to 1985, Mr. J. Tkachuk took over the editorship of the journal. In 1982, Mr. W. Capar became the editor of *Visnyk*. He renamed the newsletter *Trident-Visnyk* and it became a regular bi-monthly publication. In 1982, the society held its first exhibition-convention called UKRAINPEX at Glen Spey, NY.

In 1983, Mr. V. Zabijaka was elected president and Dr. I. Kuzych became the journal's editor in 1985.

With the 1991 elections, Mr. B. Pauk became UPNS president and took over the editorship of the newsletter. Under the leadership of the new Executive Board, UPNS expanded its contacts with philatelic chapters in Ukraine. New chapters have been formed in Ukraine, Canada and Australia. Members reside in 21 countries.

УКРАЇНСЬКЕ ФІЛАТЕЛІСТИЧНЕ І НУМІЗМАТИЧНЕ ТОВАРИСТВО

Міжнародне товариство, яке мало за ціль розвивати українську філателію і нумізматичку, було засноване в 1925 році д-р І. Турином у Відні. Товариство видавало журнал, *Український Філятеліст*, від 1925 до 1939. П.К. Лесюк, власник філателістичного підприємства в Нью-Йорку був жертвеним спонзором.

По закінченню Другої Світової війни українські філателісти в США створили ініціативну групу, що в 1951 році довело до заснування Товариства Українських Філателістів. Президентом став д-р Євген Котик, заступником Петро Войновський, секретарем Ярослав Петеш, скарбником Степан Кікта.

В червні 1951 р. появилвся журнал *Філателіст*, яким займалася видавнича колегія. Головним редактором став д-р Котик. В 1953 році до журналу впроваджено англійську частину. Під кінець 50-тих і початком 60-тих років, з браку фінансів, журнал рідко появлявся.

В 1971 році, президентом став д-р Ю. Слюсарчук і журнал почав появлятись під назвою *Український Філателіст*. В тому часі, В. Забіяка впровадив публічну ліцитацію марок.

В 1972 році, Товариство змінило свою назву на Українське Філателістичне і Нумізматичне Товариство. Вслід за тим почала появлятись додаткова публікація *Вісник*.

Від 1976 до 1985 р. редактором Українського Філателіста став Ярема Ткачук. В 1982 р. редактором *Вісника* став В. Капар. В тому ж році Товариство відбуло свою першу конвенцію получену з виставкою під назвою УКРАЇНПЕКС в Глен Спей.

В 1983 році, В. Забіяка став президентом а д-р І. Кузич в 1985 році став редактором журналу. В 1991 році президентом став Б. Паук, рівночасно перебираючи редакторство *Вісника*.

Нова управа поширила контакти з філателістичними товариствами в Україні. Нові осередки постали в Україні, Канаді і Австралії. Члени Товариства знаходяться в 21 країнах світу.
