TYPES 7 - 17

Ukraine collecting offers an exciting opportunity for collectors to obtain unique and priceless items of Ukrainian history for less than 100 dollars !

The best place to start, is the collecting of Ukrainian postcards. There are virtually no forgeries, they are beautiful, and they are cheap ! The added benefit is that with luck, a used postcard can be purchased with valuable Ukrainian postal history, for just the price of the original postcard !

You do not need to be rich to be a Ukraine collector, in fact the poorer you are and the more limited your budget, the more exciting collecting becomes, as you attempt to make every dollar count !

The Roman Dubyniak Ukrainian Museum Foundation is happy to provide a 'free of charge' opinion on any Ukrainian postcard, preferably from the original, but also from good copies of *both* sides. Advice and collecting help is free, simply write to the Foundation !

The best place to start in any collecting area, is where there are no catalogues, so prices are cheap, and just a little knowledge, like the Ukrainian language and any known literature, makes YOU the expert.

Ukrainian Legion Postcards offer such an opportunity !

The Ukrainian Legion, 1914 - 1918, was the FIRST Ukrainian military formation of modern times, and the first Ukrainian military formation for many generations .

The 'War Council' of the Ukrainian Legion issued postcards (and stamps) to raise funds for the Legion, and to provide a visual record of the deeds and exploits of the Ukrainian Legion for the Ukrainian population, who eagerly awaited news of the Legion.

The nearest thing to a catalogue is the listing provided by Borys Zayachivsky in the 'Drohobytiskiy Kolektsioner' No1 (14) 2002. We have found little or nothing else !

Dr Kyrylo Trylovskiy is the true founder of Ukrainian Legion postcards.

A co-founder of the Ukrainian Radical party which from the turn of the century fought for Ukrainian rights against the Austrian authorities, the Church - both Roman and Russian, Polish Landlords, and the Poles who occupied all the positions of power over the Ukrainian population of Halychyna, and kept Ukrainians as second class citizens and denied them their rights.

Against Polish opposition he formed for the first time Ukrainian "Sich" semi-military groups, based on traditional Kozak military lines, throughout the towns and villages of Halychyna. Officially they were volunteer "Fire-Fighting" groups, as the Poles could not oppose such formations.

In 1913, against strong Polish opposition, he managed to establish the "Ukrainian Sich Riflemen", by copying word for word the constitution of the Polish "Stszelcy" riflemen organisation.

In 1914 he became the head of the "Ukrainian War Council" and despite Polish opposition, the "Ukrainian Legion" was formed.

March 1917 Issue. The only Ukrainian Legion Issue on coloured card. Light-brown was the main colour of cards , however further printings occurred on whatever colour card was available. The most popular card proved to be ‘the road of the centuries in Ukraine’. This card was the idea of the editor of the newspaper ‘Visti z Zaporozha’, Ivan Boberskiy (treasurer of the Ukrainian Legion War Council), and was reprinted at least 4 times.

TYPE 8 “August 1917” Issue

The most interesting card shows Ivan Franko amongst Ukrainian Legionnaires in Lviv.

TYPE 9 “Kilophot” Issues

These Issues were ordered by the War Council of the Ukrainian Legion from “Kilophot” in Vienna. Kilophot put its advertising Logo on the Type 9a Issue. This must have met with the disapproval of the War Council, as this was not repeated in the Type 9b or 9c Issues.

TYPE 10 “January 1918” Issue

The very first full colour Issue of the Ukrainian Legion, since the one and only full colour card of the Type 4 Issue. Cards were numbered from 2 to 7. No doubt the one and only card of the Type 4 Issue was considered to be the ‘no.1’ !

TYPE 11 “Colour” Issue

The very first totally Ukrainian postcard Issue of the Ukrainian Legion - no German script. From the very first Issue of Ukrainian Legion postcards, it had been the hope and dream of Dr. Kyrylo Trylovskiy and the War Council, that Ukrainian Legion postcards would one day be issued in Ukrainian only, bravely, with this Issue, they fulfilled their dreams.!

Type 12 "U.M.N.A." Issue

Though there was now a shortage of everything, the War Council managed to organize one last Issue of the Ukrainian Legion. Though only black & white, it was still Ukrainian only.

TYPE 13 "Press Office" Issue

Bit of a mystery here. Why did the photographer, Officer-cadet Mykola Uhryna-Bezhrishniy, use the pseudonym Mykola Venzhyn for the 6 postcards of this Issue ?

TYPE 14 "Chervona Kalyna" Issues

Postcards issued by the magazine at the Training Unit of the Ukrainian Legion from May 1917. Type 14d were probably ordered towards the end of 1918, but never delivered.

TYPE 15 "Volodymyr-Volynskiy Komisariat" Issue

The Komisariats, though officially "recruitment centre's" for the Ukrainian Legion, they spent their time helping, assisting, and educating, the local Ukrainian people.

Borys Zayachivsky reports the following

- 15b (Series 1 no.3) The Ukrainian school, established by the Ukrainian Legion, in the village Mykulychi near Volodymyr-Volynskiy.
- 15b (Series 1 no.5) An old Ukrainian monastery from the 10th century, at the village Zymno, near Volodymyr Volynskiy.
- 15b (Series 1 no.6) Volyn. Ukrainian refugees from Polissia
- 15c (Series 2 no.3) ?
- 15c (Series 2 no.7) ?
- 15c (Series 2 no.10) The Sviatohorskiy monastery in the village Zymno. / The 'Yordan' (water blessing) in Volodymyr-Volynskiy.
- 15c (Series 2 no.11) Types of Ukrainians in Volyn
- 15c (Series 2 no.12) ?
- 15c (Series 2 no.13) ?

TYPE 16 "Podillia Komisariat" Issue

One postcard found to date, though Borys Zayachivsky reports 2 further postcards known


